

# ***Death Birth Announcement***

***Ro 6:5***

Today we will examine Romans 6:1-11 and discover ***3 truths*** of what has ***DIED in man***, and what has been made ***ALIVE in man*** when they put their faith in Christ for the forgiveness of their sins.

## **Truths:**

- 1. Believers have Died to Sin (Ro 6:1-2)**
- 2. Believers have been Crucified & Resurrected with Christ (Ro 6:3-7)**
- 3. Believers are Alive to God in Christ (Ro 6:8-11)**

## Romans 6:5 (NASB)

<sup>5</sup> For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be *in the likeness* of His resurrection,

# What is the Gospel?

## **1 Corinthians 15:3-4 (NASB)**

<sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

***Christ died for our sins (b) Christ was buried (c) Christ was resurrected***

***The Gospel is God's offer of Spiritual Life to Man***

## Romans 6:1-2 (NASB)

<sup>1</sup> What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? <sup>2</sup> **May it never be!** How shall we who died to sin still live in it?

## Romans 6:1-2 (GW)

<sup>1</sup> What should we say then? Should we continue to sin so that God's kindness will increase? <sup>2</sup> **That's unthinkable!** As far as sin is concerned, we have died. So how can we still live under sin's influence?

Paul is referring to ***Sin as an operating principle in the life of a believer.*** This operating principle of Sin, is the power of Sin. Paul is saying believers are no longer under sin's power, because of this –

***They have died to Sin, believers have died to the power of Sin, believers now have a choice by faith NOT to Sin.***

In verses 3-7, Paul tells the Roman believers HOW *they have died to sin*, and What has resulted from that death –

### **Romans 6:3 (NASB)**

<sup>3</sup> Or do you not know that all of us who have been **baptized** into Christ Jesus have been **baptized** into His death?

### **Romans 6:4 (NASB)**

<sup>4</sup> Therefore we have been **buried with Him through baptism into death**, so that as **Christ was raised** from the dead through the glory of the Father, so **we too might walk in newness of life**.

### **Romans 6:5 (NASB)**

<sup>5</sup> For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be *in the likeness* of His resurrection,

In verses 3-7, Paul tells the Roman believers **HOW they have died to sin**, and **What has resulted from that death , continued -**

### **Romans 6:6 (NASB)**

**<sup>6</sup> knowing this, that our old self was crucified with *Him*, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;**

**Old Self – Old Man, Old Adamic Self, the Person you were before Spiritual life, the Person you used to be, the Unrenewed person you were**

### **Romans 6:7 (NASB)**

**<sup>7</sup> for he who has died is freed from sin.**

# Believers are Alive to God in Christ

## Romans 6:8 (NASB)

<sup>8</sup> Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,

## Romans 6:9-10 (NASB)

<sup>9</sup> knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him. <sup>10</sup> For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.

## Romans 6:11 (NASB)

<sup>11</sup> Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

## Romans 6:11 (KJV)

<sup>11</sup> Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
